Dan attended a meeting of CCNA. At that meeting the City presented a financial accounting of the City. The City seems to be in good shape except for their pension coverage.

The Holiday Tree Lighting will possibly be Dec. 7th if a host or hostess can be found. Kelly will send an email out to people asking for a volunteer.

Jude Levy has volunteered to do a one-time newsletter for the Laurel Park neighborhood, hopefully to be distributed before October 1. Everyone concurred that it was a wonderful idea.
