Motions made after discussion:

Kate moved that if any project affects the medians or the right of way on S. Osprey, then the vegetation (trees and plants) should be replaced with the same type and size of plant (i.e. a 15" caliper live oak should be replaced with a 10"-15" caliper live oak.) Seconded by Kelly. Approved unanimously.

Kate moved that, in conjunction with affected property owners and business owners, LPNA appeal the City's decision to approve the Woman's Exchange loading dock on Rawls. Seconded by Kelly. Approved unanimously.

Kate moved that the LPNA submit a letter to the City with the appeal requesting that the appeal go directly to the City Commission. Seconded by Ginger. Approved unanimously.
